In this session we will share our thought processes and review the documents/processes we created to share theatre with patrons with sensory sensitivities. While we are not experts, we are happy to get the dialog rolling. Within 30 days of this course, participants may schedule a 30 minute one on one Zoom session with TIP's Production Manager to review your theatre's Sensory Friendly plan.
